1. May the blessings and love of the Heavenly Parent and True Parents be
with all regions and mission nations.

2. Leading the CIG settlement providence, True Parents have set up a strong
vision that all over the world of second generation be raised as future leaders
for the providence. As of 2018, the Foundation has made decisions to alter
the "Wonmo Pyeongae Global Scholarship" to "HyoJeong (HJ) Peace Academy",
to devote our efforts to foster talented people in accordance with the vision
(True Parents have set up). It is requested that each continent should
recommend students who have the will and endowments that are in
accordance with the program.

A. Qualifications

(※For further details please refer to the attached program guide.)

Candidates must satisfy all of the eight conditions below.

1) Must have citizenship other than Korean and Japanese (persons with
Korean citizenship or Korean dual citizenship, may apply by a separate set of
conditions specified in the attached guidelines).

2) High school graduates or students expecting to graduate from high
school in the summer of 2018 (students who received other academic
schooling apart from formal high school education, will be evaluated by Sun

Moon University for entrance qualification assessment).

※For further details regarding students who received other academic schooling, please refer to the attached Information for the program.

3) Students who have adequate health, both physically and mentally to study abroad for a long period of sojourn.

* All students are required to take medical examinations upon arrival in Korea, and may be rejected for further sojourn in Korea depending on the severity of their health disorder.

4) Students who have been a member of the Unification Church for at least one year and has completed 3-day Divine Principle Workshop or longer within the last 3 years.

* Each regional headquarters and national headquarters must confirm and recommend candidates.(Attach the appropriate documents required.)

* The scholarship may be stripped from the selected grantee at any time, if the grantee upon further assessment is judged to be lacking in faith, holds negative connotations to the learning environment conducive to academic pursuit, and violates the purpose of the program.

5) Students wishing to join the public mission readied by their regional Headquarters after completing their academy program.

6) Students who have not finished the undergraduate course.

7) Students who will complete the full Korean Language Course (one year) and the Undergraduate Course (four years).

* Note, students completing the 1 year Korean Language course, and going on to their undergraduate studies, will be evaluated before being given scholarship.

* Students who do not complete the program without an acceptable reason must return the scholarship funding they have received.

8) Students who accept the mandatory clauses put forth by FFWPUI, the HJ World Peace Foundation and Sun Moon University during their period of studying abroad.

* They must satisfy attendance requirements for organized events such as : HDH, Sunday Service, students' joint meetings or activities

B. Selection Procedure

1) Each regional headquarters will evaluate strictly the scholarship applications and submit their recommendations.

2) Each regional headquarters must send the applicants' documents to Sun Moon University.

3) HJ World Peace Foundation will review the recommended applicants, and announce its final decision to each regional headquarters and candidates.

C. How to Submit Documents

1) Due date : Documents must arrive at SMU by **May 14, 2018**.

2) Required documents : All documents specified in the guidelines.

* All documents must be submitted to Sun Moon University by postal mail. These must be original documents. If documents are missing, the application will not be accepted. Any submission after the due date will also not be received. (If submitting the said documents within the due date is difficult, please consult with the front office beforehand and make the necessary arrangements. Documents that have not been consulted will not be considered.)

D. Benefits for Scholarship Students

1) Korean Language Institute tuition : Full tuition fee

2) Undergraduate Course : Full tuition will be covered throughout the undergraduate course. (HJ WPF 70%, SMU 30%)

* Students with Korean dual nationality may receive 70% of the scholarship funding. (In the case the candidates' parents are faculties members for the church an additional 30% will be supported.)

3) Boarding and food expenses will be fully covered for students from the 13 strategic nations during the KLI(Korean Language Institute) course

* Applicants who are from the strategic nations must submit another application forms additionally.

* For every semester support students' boarding and food expenses are required to go through a selection process for the decisions.

4) The HJ World Peace Foundation will not be liable for other expenses apart from the ones outlined above.

E. Other Considerations

1) Please guide all potential scholarship students by informing them of what individual expenses they will need to prepare for.

2) Upon entering Korea, all scholarship students must pay approximately \$900 as dormitory fee (10 meals per week), before they are eligible to

officially enroll in the school.

3) We firmly request all regional headquarters to go through a strict selection process and only recommend **students who are willing to work for the public mission.**

4) The HJ World Peace Foundation will inform all admitted candidates individually by e-mail. If there is no reply to the e-mail, the scholarship will be canceled.
